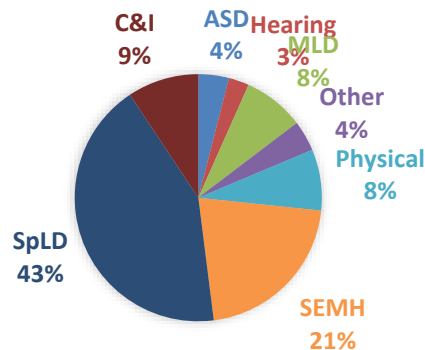


Strengths of SEND in school
